New plant manager at Bosch power tool plant in Miskolc

Tim Krause replaced Fűkő László from November

Tim Krause will take over the position of general manager of Robert Bosch Power Tool Elektromos Szerszámgyártó Kft. in Miskolc from November, 2025. The German executive replaces László Fűkő as plant manager, who will continue his professional career outside the organization after 25 years at Bosch.

Tim Krause joined the Bosch Group in 2004. He performed development, production, and management tasks in the Mobility business sector mainly at the company's German locations, including Feuerbach, Homburg, and Bühl.
